Talk It Over

- 1. What's one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- 2. What was your earliest picture of God? How did you see Him? Has your view of God changed over the years? In what ways?
- 3. Read Acts 17:22–28. In vs. 26-28, Paul describes God as both Creator and Sustainer of life. What do those descriptions mean to you? How do you understand the concept of the 'sovereignty' of God?
- 4. Read Acts 17:28–29, Matthew 6:9, & Romans 8:14-17. What is your reaction to these verses that describe God as our Father? Does your relationship with your earthly dad affect your view of God as your 'heavenly Father'? In what ways?
- 5. Read Acts 17:30–31. As you think of God as judge, what comes to mind? Is the idea of God as judge popular today? What is the appropriate response to the knowledge that God will one day judge everyone?
- 6. Acts 17:30 says that God now "commands all people everywhere to repent". What does it mean to repent? Do you think this concept well-understood and practiced by Christians today? Why or why not? Are there areas in your life where repentance is needed?
