Name It

1. What part of the message stood out to you most: Jesus raised in shame, raised bodily, raised to the throne, or our being raised with Him? Why?
2. What's something you've experienced that felt like a "fresh start" or second chance?

Know It

1. Read Matthew 28. Jesus is raised! Why do you think it matters that Jesus was raised bodily and not just spiritually?
2. Read Ephesians 2:6. What do you think that means for your identity right now?
3. Read Philippians 2:5-11. What does it mean to say "Jesus is Lord" in your daily life, not just in belief, but in authority?

Think It

1. Consider Galatians 5:22-23. Which "fruit of the Spirit" (love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control) do you most see blossoming in your life right now? Which do you need to see grow and what might that require of you?
2. The sermon used the idea of a record being "expunged." How does justification change the way you view your past sins or failures?
3. What is one fear (death, future, loss, control) that you need to actively surrender in light of the resurrection?
4. Consider Romans 6:4. How does baptism connect to dying and being raised with Christ in a real, life-changing way?
