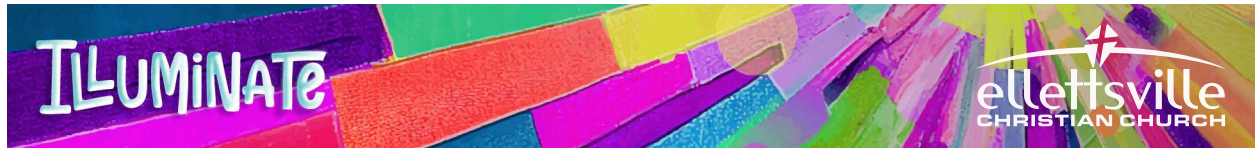

Name It

1. What is one thing that stuck out to you or was unclear to you from the sermon?
2. What's a random "lightbulb moment" you've had in life, something that suddenly clicked for you?

Know It

1. Read John 1. What words or phrases stick out to you regarding Jesus' humanity and divinity? Why?
2. Read Hebrews 4:15 and 1 John 3:5. How does Jesus' sinless life affect the way you trust Him, follow Him, or approach Him?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-15. The resurrection is described as the center of Christianity, not a side issue. Do you think the resurrection changes everything? If so, how? If not, why?

Think It

1. The sermon talked about "lightbulb moments" not being one-time experiences, but ongoing in our walk with Jesus. Have you experienced that in your faith? Why or why not?
2. What is one belief or assumption you had about God, the Bible, or Christianity growing up that changed as you got older?
3. The sermon said the biggest barrier for many people isn't evidence—it's surrender. Do you think that's true? Why might surrender be harder than intellectual belief?
4. Why does it matter that Jesus wasn't just a good moral teacher, prophet, or inspiring leader—but the unique Son of God?

Change It

1. The disciples were radically changed after encountering the risen Jesus. Where have you seen Jesus transforming you—and where might He still be calling you to deeper growth, trust, or surrender?
