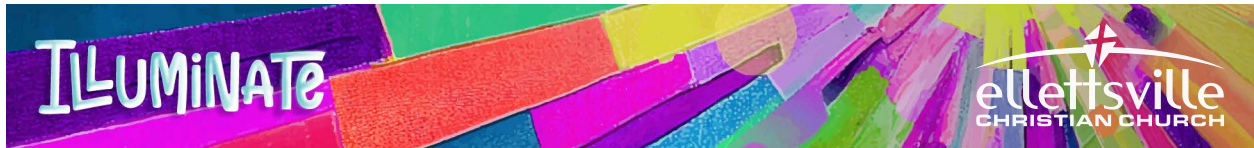

Name It

Know It

1. Read Mark 1. Name all the miracles Jesus performed. Why do you think miracles can be difficult for people to believe?
2. Read 2 Corinthians 12:7-10. What do you think Paul means when he says, "When I am weak, then I am strong?"
3. Read Colossians 1:15-17 and Psalm 19:1-4. How do you see Jesus' power at work in nature?
4. Read Romans 6:1-11. What do you think it means that death and sin "no longer are our masters?"

Think It

1. The sermon compared God's power to electricity, often unseen until we really need it. Where do you think people most overlook God's power in everyday life?
2. Romans 8 says there is "no condemnation" for those in Christ Jesus. Why is freedom from condemnation such a powerful truth?

Change It
